Their work is shaped by the tension between the real and the virtual worlds. Philosopher Jean Baudrillard writes in *Simulacra and Simulation* that reality is increasingly overlapped by simulations. The distinction between what is real and what is simulated becomes blurred. In my artistic process, a question arises:

How can I make this shift visible? I want to maintain my connection to the “real world” and yet I constantly question what is real. Nature, the city streets, and the small details of our everyday surroundings become my anchor. It is the focus on the small, the banal, that brings me back to reality.

These observations flow into my painting, which reflects both digital aesthetics and a fascination with the overwhelming stream of images. Trompe-l’œil techniques, which dissolve the boundaries between reality and illusion, play a central role. This

approach recalls Baroque painting, where illusion was not only a display of technical skill but also a metaphor for the fleeting nature of life. However, my work does not follow the tradition of *memento mori*; instead, it explores the role of perception in a world where deceptions like CGI and deep-fakes have become part of everyday life.
